ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION, UNBUNDLING, AND RESALE AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 4, 1997, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BST) and 360° Communications Company filed a request for approval of an amendment to their existing interconnection, unbundling, and resale agreement under the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. \$252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). The amendment to the agreement is attached to this Order as Attachment A and incorporated by reference herein.

Both the Act and Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, encourage parties to enter into negotiated agreements to bring about local exchange competition as quickly as possible. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved.

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The amendment to the existing agreement covers a one-year period and governs the relationship between the companies regarding local interconnection and the exchange of traffic pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 251. Under 47 U.S.C. § 252(a)(1), the agreement shall include a detailed schedule of itemized charges for interconnection and each service or network element included in the agreement.

Upon review of the proposed amendment to the existing agreement, we believe that it complies with the Telecommunications Act of 1996; thus, we hereby approve it. The Commission's approval of this agreement should not be construed as a determination that BST has met the requirements of Section 271 of the Act. BST and 360° Communications are also required to file any subsequent supplements or modifications to their agreement with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). We note that 360° Communications Company does not currently hold a Florida certificate to provide alternative local exchange telecommunications services, and therefore, it cannot provide alternative local exchange telecommunications services under this agreement until it obtains a certificate from this Commission.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the amendment to the existing interconnection, unbundling, and resale agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and 360° Communications Company, as set forth in Attachment A and incorporated by reference in this Order, is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED that any supplements or modifications to this agreement must be filed with the Commission for review under the provisions of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). It is further

ORDERED that 360° Communications Company shall not provide services under this agreement until it obtains a certificate to provide alternative local exchange telecommunications services from this Commission. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall be closed.

TO

INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN 360° COMMUNICATIONS COMPANY AND BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 1997

Pursuant to this Agreement (the "Amendment"), 360° Communications Company and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties", hereby agree to amend that certain Interconnection Agreement between the Parties effective March 1, 1997 ("Interconnection Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, 360° Communications Company and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. The Parties agree that BellSouth Telecommunications Inc. will offer and 360° Communications Company will accept the revised local interconnection rates set forth in Attachment B-1 to this Amendment, which is incorporated herein by reference, in and for the states of Florida and South Carolina. The revised rates shall be deemed effective on the dates indicated in Attachment B-1.
- 2. The Parties agree that except as specifically modified by this Amendment all other provisions of the Interconnection Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. The Parties further agree that either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to the appropriate state public service commission or other regulatory body having jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Amendment, for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
