**MOTION TO EXPEDITE DISCOVERY AND TO CHANGE DATE
FOR FILING INTERVENOR TESTIMONY**

The Citizens of Florida ("Citizens"), by and through Jack Shreve, Public Counsel, request the Commission to order KTNT Communications, Inc., d/b/a "I Don't Care" and d/b/a "It Doesn't Matter," to respond to the Citizen's Second Request for Production of Documents on or before Wednesday, March 4, 1998, and to extend the time for filing intervenor testimony by one additional week. In support of this motion, the Citizens submit the following:

1. KTNT filed direct testimony on February 13, 1998. The Citizens received this testimony on February 16, 1998.
2. The Citizens served a second set of requests for production of documents on KTNT today. It will be necessary to receive responses to these requests prior to filing testimony.



3. The current schedule requires intervenors to file testimony by Friday, March 6, 1998. Without a change in the date for response to requests for production of documents, the Citizens will not receive KTNT's discovery responses in time to use that information in intervenor testimony.

4. KTNT, without objection from the Citizens, filed testimony one week later than required by the procedural schedule. The Citizens request that intervenor due date for testimony be delayed by that same amount of time so that it will be due on Friday, March 13, 1998. This change in the date for filing intervenor testimony should not cause any change in other dates scheduled for this case.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens respectfully request the Commission to expedite responses to the Citizen's second set of requests for production of documents to KTNT and to change the due date for intervenor testimony to Friday, March 13, 1998.


