On January 28, 1998, Florida Power Corporation (FPC) and Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) filed separate Motions For Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-98-0073-FOF-EI, issued January 13, 1998, Order Determining Appropriate Treatment Of Transmission Revenues and Costs For Schedule C, Economy Energy Transactions and Requests For Oral Argument. On February 9, 1998, the Office of Public Counsel and Florida Industrial Power Users Group filed separate Responses to FPC's Motion For Reconsideration.

At the April 7, 1998, Agenda Conference, the Commissioners voted to hear oral argument from the parties. The date of the oral argument was deferred from the April 7, 1998, Agenda Conference to a subsequent Agenda Conference at the request of FPL. The Commission shall hear oral argument at the April 28, 1998, Agenda Conference and each party shall be allowed 10 minutes to make presentations. A staff recommendation on the Motions will be filed after the oral argument.
