- Scope Of FRR 0616 PSC 06: What constitutes a multi-tenant environment as discussed in Chapter 364, Florida Statutes? Are there any environments which are specifically not included?
- 2 Mandatory Access: Should property owners be required to permit any and all telecommunications carriers to serve their properties?
- 3. Exclusivity: Does a building or property owner have the ability to enter into an exclusive agreement with a LEC to provide telecommunications service to that building or property? If so, what is the COLR's obligations in that scenario?
- 4. Owner-Provided Support Structures: Should property owners be reimbursed for costs to provide pathways and spaces used by telecommunications providers?
- 5. <u>Access Fees</u>: Should property owners be permitted to assess fees to telecommunications providers in exchange for the right to provide service to tenants? If a building or property owner charges a telecommunications company or end user for telecommunications facilities should the building or property owner be certificated by the FPSC?

- 9. Owner/Tenant Fees: May an owner impose fees on tenants for telecommunications services or equipment which are not, either directly or indirectly, provided by the owner?
