Docket No. 951560-TP
 Rules relating to pay telephone service providers.

The following are technical corrections that are necessary to be made to the pay telephone service provider rules that were found after the recommendation was filed. The corrections will be offered at the agenda conference.

Page 24, line 14 and 15 Add Subsection (5); delete "All" and other references that have been struck.

Page 29, line 9 After 800 add: 877. Between the time the consensus rules were submitted to RRR staff, additional 800 numbers (877) have been added.

Page 30, line 18 After "such as" the sentence should read: "10XXX+1, 10XXXX+0, 101XXX+0, 950,".

Page 31, lines 9 and 10 Add 10XXX, after 10XXX; Add 877, after 800.

Page 36, line 14 This line should read: access codes such as 10XXX, 10XXXX, 101XXX, 950, and toll free (e.g., (800, 877, and 888),. Everything on line 14 should be struck or deleted and on line 15 strike "1-888 access codes,".

Page 39, line 20 Delete "may"; reinstate "shall". This change will make the set use fee language consistent with the language in the operator service provider rules.
