  - OPC: It depends on the magnitude of the change which would be implemented for October -December, 1998, as well as the expected change in January, 1999. FPUC's new factor for its Fernandina Beach Division, for example, would reduce charges substantially, by \$4.34 for a 1,000 KWH residential customer. This lower charge should be implemented for October - December, 1998, unless, perhaps, an offsetting increase would be required for January - December, 1999. FPC's witness, Mr. Wieland, recommends that current factors should be continued for October -December, 1998, because the difference is so small. But his comparison is based upon a continuation of the current factor versus one based upon an October, 1998 -March, 1999, projection period. Tampa Electric's witness Zwolak, on the other hand, recommends continuation of the current factor based upon projected costs for the period October, 1998 - December, 1998. Gulf's position is apparently consistent with Tampa Electric's.
