PURPOSE

The purpose of the public service hearings is to permit members of the general public, including customers of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., Sprint-Florida, Incorporated, and Vista-United Telecommunications, to present testimony on any and all issues in the case relating to the proposed changes to the 407 area code. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.


The public service hearings will begin as scheduled and will continue until all witnesses have been heard. If no witnesses are present, the service hearings may be adjourned. All persons desiring to present testimony are urged to appear at the beginning of the service hearings.
