BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

1. On October 28, 1998, BellSouth filed its response to Staff's Second Request for Production of Documents, incorrectly identified by Staff as Staff's First Request for Production of Documents, which requested copies of completed spreadsheets containing certain revenue information produced by BellSouth to the FCC. On that same day, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification for the documents it produced that contained certain revenue information. BellSouth is now filing a Request for Confidential Classification for the information provided in response to Request 1 of Staff's Second Request for Production of Documents, incorrectly identified as Staff's First Request for Production of Documents.

2. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A a listing of the information designated by BellSouth as proprietary.

3. Appended hereto as Attachment B are two copies of the subject exhibit with the proprietary information deleted.

4. Appended hereto as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the exhibit, including the material which is proprietary.

5. The subject documents contain information regarding certain revenue information for BellSouth by class of customer. This information is commercially sensitive information that is not disclosed to the public. Disclosure of this confidential information could substantially harm the competitive position of BellSouth by assisting competitors in analyzing market opportunities, and in preparing marketing strategies to use in direct competition with BellSouth. Thus, if this information were disclosed publicly, it would damage the competitive interests of BellSouth. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Florida Statutes § 364.183(3)(e).

6. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

7. The original of this Request has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information.

to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential,
