CASE BACKGROUND

On September 27, 1994, the Board of County Commissioners of Charlotte County adopted Resolution No. 94-195, pursuant to Section 367.171, Florida Statutes, declaring that, as of September 27, 1994, the water and wastewater utilities in that County shall become subject to the provisions of the Water and Wastewater Regulatory Law, Chapter 367, Florida Statutes. The resolution was acknowledged by this Commission on November 28, 1994, by Order No. PSC-94-1451-FOF-WS.

This docket was opened in order to acknowledge Charlotte County's resolution, to ensure that all jurisdictional entities filed applications for certificates or exemptions and to process certain exemption applications. Subsequent to the time this docket was opened, Section 367.022, Florida Statutes, became self-executing. Utilities that meet the requirements of Section 367.022, Florida Statutes, no longer have to apply for exemption
