<u>Issue 1</u>: What amendments, if any, are necessary to address combinations that recreate a BST retail service?

<u>Recommendation</u>: On a going-forward basis, as it relates to the interconnection agreements of AT&T-BST and MCIm-BST, the prices for UNE combinations, whether or not they are in existence, or whether or not they recreate an existing retail service, should be determined based on the same pricing standard for UNE combinations that do not recreate a retail service. Therefore, staff recommends that the Commission order the parties to incorporate the language proposed by staff in Attachments A and B to their August 19, 1999 memorandum.

<u>Issue 2</u>: What amendments, if any, are necessary to incorporate the nonrecurring charges for certain loop and port combinations? <u>Recommendation</u>: The non-recurring charges approved by the Commission and shown in Table II on page 68 of Order PSC-98-0810-FOF-TP should be incorporated in the MCIm-BST and AT&T-BST agreements. Accordingly, staff recommends that the Commission order the parties to incorporate the language proposed by staff in Attachments A and B to their memorandum.

<u>Issue 3</u>: What further actions are necessary to incorporate the Commission's other decisions in Order PSC-98-0810-FOF-TP? <u>Recommendation</u>: No further actions are needed.
