

## PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM'S PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Peoples Gas System ("PGS") hereby submits its preliminary statement of issues and positions

to be addressed at the hearing now scheduled to commence on November 22, 1999 in this docket.

<u>ISSUE</u>: What is the end-of-period final true-up amount for the period April 1, 1998 through March 31, 1999?

PGS (except West Florida): \$446,455 overrecovery.

PGS (West Florida): \$204,737 overrecovery.

<u>ISSUE</u>: What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 1 through December 31, 2000?

<u>PGS (except West Florida)</u>: The appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 1 through December 31, 2000 are as follow:

- <u>ISSUE</u>: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?
  - <u>PGS</u>: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2000, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2000, so that each customer is billed for 12 months regardless of when such adjustment factor becomes effective.
