PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM'S PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Peoples Gas System ("PGS") hereby submits its preliminary statement of issues and positions to be taken up at the hearing now scheduled to begin on November 22, 1999 in this docket.

Issue 1: What is the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period April 1998 through December 1998?

PGS's Position:

\$4,088,862 overrecovery.

Issue 2: What is the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January 1999 through December 1999?

PGS's Position:

\$3,807,198 underrecovery.

Issue 3: What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be refunded in the January 2000 - December 2000 period?

PGS's Position:

\$281,665 overrecovery.

Issue 4: What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas recovery (cap) factor to be charged during the period January 2000 through December 2000?

PGS's Position:

55.097 cents per therm.

<u>Issue 5</u>: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

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PGS's Position:

The factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2000, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for the period January 2000 through December 2000.
