DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission approve Florida Public Utilities Company's petition for approval of its revised lighting service rate schedules?


<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Yes, the proposed revisions should be approved with an effective date of November 16, 1999. (DRAPER)

STAFF ANALYSIS: Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) has proposed to add several new fixtures and poles to its Outdoor Lighting Service and Street Lighting Service rate schedules. The new fixture and pole offerings will be available for the Marianna Division and Fernandina Beach Divisions. FPUC states that several customers have requested that FPUC offer a larger variety of decorative fixtures and poles.

Staff has reviewed all the workpapers and believes that they are reasonable. Staff recommends that the tariff revisions be approved with an effective date of November 16, 1999.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes, if Issue 1 is approved, this tariff should become effective on November 16, 1999. If a protest is filed within 21 days of the issuance of the order, this tariff should remain in effect with any increase held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed upon the issuance of a consummating order. (COLLINS)

STAFF ANALYSIS: At the conclusion of the protest period, if no protest is filed, this docket should be closed upon the issuance of a consummating order.
