I object to Intercoastal Utilities, Inc. expanding coverage to additional areas for the following reasons:

1. They have not demonstrated the ability to efficiently manage the operations for the areas they currently cover as evidenced by their recent significant rate increases without any improvement in service.

2. They have no incentive to operate efficiently since rises in costs are passed on to the consumers and thereby increasing the base on which their profit allowance is computed.
