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PROCEEDINGS 1 2 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Call the prehearing to order. 3 Will you please read the notice. 4 MS. CALDWELL: Thank you. Notice was issued on 5 February 23rd, of the year 2000, that this prehearing 6 would take place at this time and date in Docket Number 7 991237-TP. 8 COMMISSIONER CLARK: We'll take appearances. 9 MS. FOSHEE: Lisa Foshee and Michael Goggin on 10 behalf of BellSouth. 11 MR. HATCH: Tracy Hatch appearing on behalf of 12 AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. 13 MS. CALDWELL: Diana Caldwell appearing on 14 behalf of the staff of the Florida Public Service 15 Commission. 16 17 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Ms. Foshee, I appreciate you standing up, but we 18 are a little less formal than court. 19 MS. FOSHEE: Thank you. I have been informed by 20 Mr. Goggin. 21 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Thank you. 22 I have read through the prehearing order. So, 23 Diana, why don't you tell me how you want to conduct this 24 prehearing. 25 FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

1	MS. CALDWELL: At your pleasure, Commissioner
2	Clark. I think that the parties do have some minor
3	changes.
4	COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. We will start
5	with you, Ms. Foshee. Do you have some changes that you
6	would like to make to the prehearing order?
7	MS. FOSHEE: Commissioner Clark, the only thing
8	I would like to raise, if this is the appropriate time, is
9	that BellSouth would like to request the opportunity to
10	make a very brief opening statement at the beginning of
11	the hearing. I think this case lends itself to that type
12	of statement, and we would request the opportunity to do
13	that.
14	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Hatch.
15	MR. HATCH: I was going to ask for the same
16	thing, so that is fine with us.
17	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. How much time do you
18	think?
19	MS. FOSHEE: Five minutes.
20	MR. HATCH: Yes, five minutes would be fine.
21	That's what I was thinking.
22	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Is this the full
23	Commission?
24	MR. HATCH: It's a panel, I believe.
25	MS. CALDWELL: I think we are a panel.
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COMMISSIONER CLARK: Is Commissioner Garcia on 1 2 it? MS. CALDWELL: I do not believe so. 3 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Probably five minutes if he 4 is on it. We could go ten if he is not. 5 MS. CALDWELL: He is not on it. 6 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Let's just say at 7 the outside ten, or is five good? 8 MR. HATCH: Five would probably work, ten to be 9 safe. But I don't intend to belabor anything, I can 10 11 assure you. COMMISSIONER CLARK: We will put in there five 12 to ten minutes. 13 MS. FOSHEE: Thank you very much. 14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Good. 15 MS. FOSHEE: And other than that, we had no 16 other matters, Commissioner. 17 COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. I assume we 18 will make some -- can we make corrections, grammatical 19 corrections that you noted? Where were they? 20 MS. CALDWELL: I didn't have any in particular. 21 I think Mr. Hatch --22 MR. HATCH: I've got a couple of grammatical 23 corrections that I need to fix in the positions to make 24 them make sense. 25

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1	COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. Like, for	
2	instance, where you have the sics indicating, you know, it	
3	was an error in the original?	
4	MR. HATCH: That is exactly right. There is an	
5	error on Page 5 in our basic position. There is a couple	
6	of sics. And the way that should read, if you start	
7	from see, the first about halfway down there, the first	
8	sic? If you go just before that it says, "After CCL	
9	charges," it should read, from the comma it should read,	
10	"Terminating CCL charges or both." The "or a" should be	
11	stricken at the end of that previous line.	
12	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. We'll just	
13	MR. HATCH: The next one is down there prior to	
14	the next sic.	
15	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay.	
16	MR. HATCH: And strike the word "where" at the	
17	beginning of that line.	
18	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay.	
19	MR. GOGGIN: On the following page, Page 7 in	
20	BellSouth's position similarly, on the second line the	
21	word that follows the acronym charge and sic could both be	
22	deleted.	
23	COMMISSIONER CLARK: I have that on Page 6.	
24	MR. GOGGIN: I'm sorry, you are correct. It is	
25	easy to understand how these mistakes get there now, isn't	
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l it?

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2 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. That's the only one 3 I saw for BellSouth. Is there any other minor changes you 4 need to make?

5 MR. HATCH: Page 7 is the next one for me. If 6 you look in the position on Paragraph D, foreign exchange, 7 in the third line, the third line should say, "Central 8 office at the open end and carried," instead of carrier. 9 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay.

10 "Via a dedicated," which has got a MR. HATCH: 11 typo in it, "Dedicated line to an FX customer's premises." 12 The next sentence has a typo in it, as well. It says, 13 "BellSouth's bills terminating CCL charges to AT&T, even though no common line is used to carry, " instead of 14 15 carrier. Those are the only typos that I found. 16 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Is that it? 17 MR. HATCH: Yes, as far as typographicals go. 18 I have one other thing to add at some point. 19 COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. Why don't we go 20 to that.

21 MR. HATCH: The post-hearing limitation on 50 22 words in a position. For purposes of Issue 1, because it 23 is really only a factual technical issue, describing the 24 call flows in Issue 1 for each of the words, for example, 25 in AT&T's position if you look on Page 7 of call

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1	forwarding, in order to make that make sense it has to be	
2	longer than 50 words.	
3	COMMISSIONER CLARK: That's fine. Should I rule	
4	that in post-hearing	
5	MR. HATCH: I don't anticipate my position	
6	post-hearing will change from this. It could get shorter	
7	if I can squeeze some language out of it, but I won't be	
8	any longer than that.	
9	COMMISSIONER CLARK: We will indicate for Issue	
10	1 the 50-word limit can be exceeded.	
11	MR. HATCH: That's fine. Thank you.	
12	MR. GOGGIN: That would be true for both	
13	parties, correct?	
14	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Absolutely. Anything else,	
15	Mr. Hatch?	
16	MR. HATCH: That seems to be it.	
17	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Staff.	
18	MS. CALDWELL: Staff has nothing further to add.	
19	COMMISSIONER CLARK: There being nothing further	
20	to take up, this prehearing is adjourned.	
21	Thank you very much.
