Issue 2: Should the Commission grant BellSouth's Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-00-0537-FOF-TP?

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Commission deny in part and grant in part BellSouth's Motion for Reconsideration. Staff recommends that the Commission deny BellSouth's request to reconsider its finding that the rate for reciprocal compensation should be \$0.009. Staff further recommends that the Commission delete the statement that BellSouth failed to provision unbundled network elements in such a manner as to provide ITC^DeltaCom Communications, Inc. with a meaningful opportunity to compete with BellSouth from the Order to correct a scrivener's error. Finally, staff recommends that the Commission grant BellSouth's request for reconsideration of the application fee for collocation and set the fee at \$3,248.00.

<u>Issue 3</u>: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: No. The parties should be required to submit a signed agreement that complies with the Commission's decisions in this docket for approval within 20 days of issuance of the Commission's Order. This docket should remain open pending Commission approval of the final arbitration agreement in accordance with Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
