the Commission's denial of the requested transfer. Petitioner shall provide these ultimate facts after the

results of discovery are received. The Petitioner's Prehearing Statement will include these ultimate facts, if

they are not provided sooner.

7. The specific rules or statutes which require the Commission to deny the proposed transfer:

a. Chapter 367.045, Florida Statutes

b. Chapter 367.071, Florida Statues

c. Commission Rule 25-30.037, Florida Administrative Code.

8. Based upon the Petitioner's understanding of this case at this time, the Petitioner requests the

Commission to deny the Utility's application for authority to transfer its water and wastewater facilities to

NFMU.
