Dear Ms. Bayó:

Please accept for filing the original and fifteen (15) copies of this letter as Florida Power & Light Company's ("FPL") request for a rule development workshop in connection with the Notice of Proposed Rule Development issued in the above-numbered and entitled proceeding and published November 3, 2000 in the Florida Administrative Weekly. This request is made pursuant to Section 120.54(2)(c), Florida Statues, and Rule 28-103.002 of the Florida Administrative Code.

FPL submits that a suitable number of workshops should be conducted relative to the development of amendments to Rule 25-17.0832 (the "Rule"). The issues to be addressed are complex and potentially controversial. For example, the removal of a subscription limit for standard offers where capacity is not avoided, without additional changes to the Rule, would increase the likelihood of customer-subsidization of qualifying facilities, a result FPL contends is not appropriate under either Federal or Florida law. For these same reasons, the proposed amendments to the Rule necessarily will involve competing points of view and will have a significant impact on regulated interests. A rule development workshop would assist the Commission and its Staff to better understand and address the concerns of the affected entities, including investor-owned utilities such as FPL.
