Dear Mr. McMillan:

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This is in response to your January 17 letter concerning your pay telephone certificate that was cancelled effective October 24, 2000 in the above docket. Your certificate was cancelled for nonpayment of the 1999 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) after Order No. PSC-00-1781-PAA-TC was issued on September 29, 2000. According to the Order, you had until October 20 to protest. When no protest nor payment of the past due amount was received, a Consummating Order was issued on October 24.

You also asked how to get the payphone currently installed at your business removed so that

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To prevent the 1999 and 2000 RAFs from being forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for further collection attempts, you should pay the outstanding amount in full. If your payment for the 1999 RAF is mailed by February 24, you will owe \$69.00 (\$50.00 fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$6.50 interest). If your payment for the 2000 RAF is mailed by the due date of January 30, you will owe only the \$50.00 minimum. If the 2000 payment is postmarked by March 1, you will owe \$53.00 (\$50.00 fee, \$2.50 penalty, and \$0.50 interest).

You also asked how to get the payphone currently installed at your business removed so that you can install your own. Each pay telephone must be labeled as to which company owns and operates it. You should call that payphone company and ask that it be removed. If the other payphone company has a contract, you may have to seek legal counsel to get the payphone removed.

As far as installing your own payphone, unfortunately, that cannot be done. Rule 25-24.511(5), Florida Administrative Code, states that "Only one certificate per applicant will be granted. A new certificate will not be granted to any applicant who has previously had a certificate involuntarily cancelled." In this case, your certificate was involuntarily cancelled for nonpayment of the RAF.

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
