On July 17, 2000, when copies of certain portions of staff's audit working papers obtained regarding the FPL energy conservation cost recovery clause audit for the year ended December 31, 1999, were delivered to FPL at the audit exit conference, the utility requested that these materials be temporary excepted from public access in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(2), Florida Administrative Code (FAC). On July 19, 2000, staff filed document 08718-00 consisting of those specified portions of the audit working papers.

On August 7, 2000, the utility filed a request pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, FAC, and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), that selected portions of the working papers prepared by staff during the audit receive confidential classification. The utility's request includes redacted copies for public inspection (Exhibit B, document 09550-00) and highlighted copies (document 09551-00).

Documents 08718-00 and 09551-00 are currently held by the Commission's Division of Records and Reporting as confidential pending resolution of FPL's request for confidential classification.

Pursuant to Section 119.07, F.S., documents submitted to this Commission are public records. The only exceptions to this law are specific statutory exemptions and exemptions granted by governmental agencies pursuant to the specific items of a statutory provision. Subsection 366.093(3)(e) provides the following exemption:

Page 2 FPL Confidential Protection Conservation Audit August 16, 2000

"Proprietary confidential business information means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. Proprietary confidential business information includes but is not limited to:....

(e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would harm the competitive interests of the provider of the information....

According to Section 366.093, F.S., and Rule 25-22.006, FAC, the utility has the burden of demonstrating that materials qualify for confidential classification. According to rule 25-22.006, FAC, the utility must meet this burden by demonstrating that the information is proprietary confidential business information, the disclosure of which will cause the utility, the provider of the information or the ratepayer harm.

#### Staff Analysis of the Request

Reading the FPL request reveals the sensitive materials consist of portions of:

- 1. Billing histories and reports;
- 2. Tests of expenditures:
- 3. Listings of Commercial Industrial Load Control (CILC) Billings; and
- 4. CILC agreements.

According to the testimony of FPL employee Dennis Brandt, Director, Product and Support Services, the sensitive materials consist of customer-specific account information for non governmental customers. Mr. Brandt reports FPL's policy is not to reveal customer information unless required to do so by law or unless the customer authorizes its release. "FPL Customer information" includes, but is not limited to: customer names, addresses, telephone numbers, account numbers, rates, billing determinants (kW and kWh Usage), conservation savings in kW, and bills. Mr. Brandt reports FPL customers have affirmed their right to keep this information confidential. He also indicates that keeping customer information private is an important concern with FPL customers for a variety of reasons including; keeping sensitive competitive busness information from competitiors and, for other customers, retaining their privacy.

Within their request, FPL cites: Commission Order PSC-96-1478, dated December 4, 1996; Commission Order PSC 98-0421, dated March 24, 1998; and Commission Order 98-0620, dated May 4, 1998, as evidence of prior Commission decisions in similar matters. These Commission Orders demonstrate a long standing policy for the Commission to grant confidential classification to specific customer usage information. These three orders grant protection covering a variety customer usage related topics, such as:

- A) Identity of customers;
- B) Rate under which a customer takes service;
- C) Payback alternatives considered by the customers;
- D) Nature of capital improvements customers have considered and may still be considering;
- E) Name of persons who have performed analyses for the customers;
- F) Nature of studies customers have commissioned to reduce costs and make them more competitive;
- G) Billing determinants;
- H) Load Shape;
- I) Billing Data; and
- J) Ratepayer complaints filed directly with the utility.

In fact, within the materials considered by the Commission by these three Orders, only ratepayer complaints filed directly with the Commission were found to be public record and therefore not eligible for a confidential classification.

Reading the sensitive material in this case reveals it is customer-specific usage information which mets the definition of proprietary confidential business information release of which could cause the provider of the information harm. We found no customer complaints filed with the Commission within these sensitive materials. We therefore recommend that a confidential classification be granted to the sensitive materials presented in this filing.

#### <u>Duration of the Confidential Classification Period</u>

The utility requests that the material be granted confidential classification for not less than 18 months and that the information should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer needed by the Commission.

Records retention for these audit working papers is 25 years. Provisions of Section 366.093(4), F.S., absent good cause shown for a longer period, limit a confidential classification to 18 months. We therefore recommend that the period of classification be set as 18 months; however, the utility may request an extension of this period before the protection tolls.
