Wayne, back in January you all took a tour of BellSouth, Sprint, and Verizon's offices and came back with some pix that were put on CD. The CDs were given to the companies and then in Feb we got the following:

withdrawal of notice of intent by BellSouth for its pix
Letter from Verizon claiming confidentiality of the pix

3. Claim of confidentiality from Sprint for the pix

As I understood it at the time the CDs were turned over to the companies, the original (and only) copies were given to the companies. I suspect Verizon and Sprint think the PSC is still in possession of copies of the pix. (At least Sprint says in its claim, "Copies . . do not accompany this request as they are already in the possession of staff and staff's witnesses . . . ")

Do you still have copies of the pix either on the cartridge from the digital camera or on your computer? If so, those of Sprint and Verizon need to be loaded on CD and brought to us for safekeeping in the conf. files.
