Dear Ms. Bayo:

Our law firm represents Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. ("Time Warner"). On behalf of our client, we would like to request confidential classification of "Exhibit A" which is attached to Time Warner's response to Verizon's discovery request. Specifically, we would like to request confidential classification of the responses in the tables labeled Revised Switching Questions, Loop Questions and Transport Questions. These documents were initially filed with the commission in response to the Federal Communication Commission's Triennial Unbundled Network Element Review and pursuant to a cooperative agreement between BellSouth and Time Warner.

Time Warner's request for confidential classification is made pursuant to Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code. The information contained in this document is considered proprietary confidential business information, as that term is defined in Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes. As such, this information is exempt from Section 119.07(1) and Section 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. The information is a trade secret and relates to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of Time Warner. Additionally, the information is intended to be private, and has not been otherwise disclosed by Time Warner.

In accordance with Rule 22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, I have enclosed one highlighted copy and two redacted copies of the relevant documents.


