I agree that the residents and businesses in North Miami will best be served by the placing the 138-kilowatt transmission lines underground.

The six-year trimming cycle would be a disaster if implemented. A six-year cycle would guarantee that above ground lines would come down in a storm. Too much growth would occur within the cycle. I agree that preventative measures are needed, but a six-year cycle would prevent nothing.
