### Commission to Consider Mandating Inspections for Electric, Phone Company Poles

**TALLAHASSEE** — The Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) will consider ordering 10-year inspection cycles for all wooden poles that carry investor-owned electric lines at its February 7, 2006 meeting.

The vulnerability of wooden utility poles to damage or failure during the 2004 and 2005 hurricane seasons has been cited as a possible cause of extensive and protracted power outages.

"We have a responsibility to look for short-term and long-term answers that will reduce the impacts of storms on Florida's ratepayers," Commission Chairman Lisa Polak Edgar said. "In light of the unprecedented damage of the last two years, we will be pursuing solutions and considering actions to protect our consumers."

A staff recommendation filed Friday recommends the state's investorowned electric utilities and local telephone companies inspect 10 percent of their wooden utility poles annually using specified techniques and report the findings to the Commission. Staff recommendations may be accepted, rejected or modified by the Commissioners.

The recommendation notes that federal guidelines for rural electric cooperatives suggest 10-year inspection cycles for wooden poles in most states and eight-year cycles in Florida.

While acknowledging a comprehensive inspection program may involve some added costs for utilities, staff concludes, "An effective pole inspection program can be expected to reduce future storm damage totals."

### Commission Orders Wood Pole Inspection Programs for Electric and Telephone Companies

**TALLAHASSEE** — Comprehensive inspections of wooden utility poles used by investor-owned electric utilities and telephone companies will be conducted every 8 years, the Florida Public Service Commission ordered Tuesday.

By a four-to-one vote, the five-member Commission said initiating the inspection programs is one of a number of steps aimed at making the state's utilities less susceptible to damage from hurricanes and tropical storms.

"This is one of a number of initiatives we'll be taking to reduce our vulnerability to long-term outages," Commission Chairman Lisa Polak Edgar said. "Our ratepayers and our utilities have taken a beating over the last two years and we have to move forward with solutions."

The 2004 and 2005 hurricane seasons set records not only for the number of storms to hit the state, but for the damage caused to critical infrastructure, resulting in lengthy outages of electric and telephone service.

Under the plan adopted by the Commission Tuesday, companies will be responsible for conducting specific tests to wooden poles on a cycle that insures each pole is tested at least once every 8 years.





# **PSC Approves Embarq Wooden Pole Inspection Plan**

**TALLAHASSEE** — Addressing concerns regarding the risk of wooden pole failure in storm events, the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) approved a comprehensive wooden pole inspection plan Tuesday for Embarg Florida, Inc. (Embarg).

"This plan is part of the larger effort to reduce the state's vulnerability to hurricanes," said Chairman Lisa Polak Edgar.

Under the plan approved by the Commission, Embarq will be responsible for inspecting all of its wooden poles at least once every eight years. Embarq must take corrective action on any poles found to be defective or not strong enough to carry their load. Trussing or bracing may be used in areas with greater pole decay due to environmental problems or bug infestation. Embarq maintains approximately 38,800 wood poles within its service area.

In a February 2006 order, the Commission required all of Florida's incumbent local exchange companies (ILECs) to implement wood pole inspection programs based upon an eight-year cycle. Similar requirements were also made for Florida's investor-owned electric utilities.

The wooden pole inspection program is one of several measures taken to detect decay and help prevent structural failures of telecommunications and electric systems during storms. Other measures include an audit of joint-use attachment agreements, a transmission structure inspection program, and an analysis of pole failures after severe storms.
