Dear Mayor Lee:

I am writing to acknowledge receipt of the Town of Briny Breezes' resolution supporting the conversion of overhead electric distribution facilities to underground facilities and encouraging the Florida Public Service Commission to implement all reasonable measures to encourage the conversion of electric distribution facilities to underground facilities. The resolution was filed in several dockets for the Florida Public Service Commission's consideration: Docket No. 060172-EU - Proposed rules governing placement of new electric distribution facilities underground, and conversion of existing overhead distribution facilities to underground facilities, to address effects of extreme weather events; Docket No. 060173-EU - Proposed amendments to rules regarding overhead electric facilities to allow more stringent construction standards than required by National Electric Safety Code; and Docket No. 060150-EI - Petition for approval of revisions to contribution-in-aid-of-construction definition in Section 12.1 of First Revised Tariff Sheet No. 6.300, by Florida Power & Light Company.
