REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO STAFF'S THIRD SET OF INTERROGATORIES (NO. 16)

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided in connection with Interrogatory No. 16, which was served by Staff on October 11, 2007. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. FPL served its answers to Staff's Third Set of Interrogatories on Monday, October 22, 2007 for overnight delivery to Staff on October 23, 2007. This request is being filed contemporaneously with the delivery of the answers to Staff and is intended to request confidential classification of the confidential portions of Interrogatory No. 16 (the "Confidential Discovery Response") consistent with Rule 25-22.006.
 - 2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
- a. Composite Exhibit A consists of a copy of FPL's response to Interrogatory

 No. 16, on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been
 highlighted. Composite Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked
 "CONFIDENTIAL."
- b. Composite Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Exhibit A on which all information in Interrogatory No. 16 that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.

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- c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.
- d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Gerard J. Yupp, who is the Manager of Regulated Wholesale Power Trading in the Energy Marketing and Trading Division.
- 3. FPL seeks confidential protection for the information highlighted in Exhibit A. The highlighted information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e) because it consists of fuel hedging information that comprises trade secrets of FPL, which allow FPL to purchase and sell fuel and electric power on favorable terms for FPL and its customers. The disclosure of that trade-secret information would provide other participants in the fuel and electric power markets insight into FPL's marketing and trading practices that would allow them to anticipate FPL's marketing and trading decisions and/or impair FPL's ability to negotiate, to the detriment of FPL and its customers.
- 4 FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3). Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law.
- 5. The highlighted information in Exhibit A is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained.
- 6. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibit C, is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to

FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4).

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the Confidential Discovery Response as described herein.
