By letter received December 13, 2007, Frontier Communications of the South, LLC filed a request for approval of the interconnection and traffic interchange agreement for commercial mobile radio services between Frontier Communications of the South, Inc. and Sprint Spectrum L.P. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was March 12, 2008.
