Verizon Southwest (collectively "Verizon") hereby submit this Application for authority

under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act and Section 63.71 of the Commission's

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rules to discontinue its Internet Protocol-Virtual Private Network Service (IP-VPN) at digital speeds below 200 Kbps.

Verizon offered IP-VPN service in California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida,

Maryland, Massachusetts, New York, New Jersey, North Carolina, Oregon,

Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Texas, Virginia, Washington, and Washington, D.C.

Verizon's IP-VPN service has been closed to new customers since September 30, 2006.

There currently are no customers for IP-VPN service at digital speeds below 200 Kbps.

Subject to the Commission's authorization of the proposed discontinuance, Verizon will

discontinue this service in all of the above jurisdictions on or about September 12, 2008.

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

Subject to the Commission's authorization of the proposed discontinuance pursuant to

Section 63.71(c) of the Commission's rules, Verizon will discontinue its IP-VPN service on or

about September 12, 2008.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

Verizon offered IP-VPN Service in California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Maryland, Massachusetts, New York, New Jersey, North Carolina, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Texas, Virginia, Washington and Washington, D.C. and will discontinue IP-VPN service in those jurisdictions.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(4), b(2)):

IP-VPN Service is a packet-based advanced data service that provides connectivity between customer locations. Uses of this service include, but are not limited to, enabling enterprise customers to communicate with branch offices, exchange corporate network traffic, and establish communication with external partners (*i.e.* customers, business partners and suppliers). There currently are no customers for this service at digital speeds below 200 Kbps. Subject to the Commission's authorization of the proposed discontinuance, this service will be discontinued on or about September 12, 2008.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by this proposed service discontinuance because there currently are no customers for Verizon's IP-VPN service.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (b)(3)):

There currently are no customers for Verizon's IP-VPN service at digital speeds below 200 Kbps. Accordingly, there are no customers to notify concerning the proposed discontinuance.

Copies of this Application are being sent via first class U.S. Mail to the governor and public utilities commission for each affected state, and also to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

Verizon is considered dominant with respect to the service to be discontinued.
