Dear Mr. Eubanks:

Attached is a copy of the application of Sun River Utilities, Inc. application for amendment of its water certificate in Charlotte and DeSoto Counties. Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) and the Public Service Commission (PSC), the DCA has agreed to provide input on need for service and comprehensive plan consistency on applications for certificate amendments filed with the PSC.

Charlotte County rescinded Public Service Commission jurisdiction last fall, and as a result, the PSC canceled the water and wastewater certificates held by Sun River Utilities. Subsequent to the change in jurisdiction, Sun River has proposed enlarging its service area to include land in DeSoto County as well as Charlotte County, which has caused the utility to seek recertification from the PSC pursuant to Section 367.171, Florida Statutes. This application is for the territory that Sun River had previously been authorized to serve by the PSC, as well as the new parcels proposed to be served in Charlotte and DeSoto Counties delineated on Exhibit C-2 in the application.
