Florida City Gas: A total of \$2,088,536.

4. What should be the effective date of the conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

Florida City Gas:

The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2010 through December 2010. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2010 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2010, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

Company specific issue:

5. Has FCG appropriately included costs associated with the issuance of conservation program rebate checks in 2008 in the true-up amount for the period January 2008 through December 2008?

<u>Florida City Gas:</u> Yes. The amounts identified are associated with the issuance of rebate checks for FCG conservation programs, and thus, properly identified for recovery through the clause.
