This letter is in response to your February 4, 2010 letter entitled "Re: Docket No. 090002-EG, August 19, 2009 Request for Confidential Classification for PSC staff audit working papers prepared during Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Clause Audit for the Year Ended December 31, 2008, Audit control number 09-028-4-1, documents numbered 07900-09 and 08665-09" (the "February 4 letter"). In your February 4 letter, you raised five issues with Florida Power & Light's ("FPL's") August 19, 2009 Request for Confidential Classification, and asked for a response from FPL to those issues within 21 days. I am hereby responding to the identified issues and providing a Revised Exhibit C. I will file a copy of this response as well as revised exhibits to FPL's August 19, 2009 Request for Confidential Classification with the Commission Clerk. The revised pages for Exhibits A and B are highlighted and redacted copies of certain Working Papers. The revised highlighted and redacted pages are intended to replace the similarly numbered copies of Working Papers FPL filed with its August 19, 2009 Request for Confidential Classification. Also attached is a revised Exhibit C.

Issue 1: Compensation Information

FPL's request that certain information related to employee compensation, duties, qualifications or responsibilities located within the documents, receive confidential treatment is not made pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(f), F.S. Consistent with Exhibit C, which was attached to FPL's August 19, 2009 Request for Confidential Classification, FPL has requested confidential classification of certain employee information pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. As more fully set forth in several requests for confidential classification filed by FPL in docket 080677-EI,¹ this information is competitively sensitive to FPL, and its disclosure would harm FPL's competitive business as well as its customers by increasing compensation-related costs. Such information is specifically entitled to confidential treatment under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Additionally, disclosure of this information would violate employees'


constitutionally-protected rights to privacy. This employee compensation information in the Working Papers is the same type of information that is currently subject to appeal in Florida's First District Court of Appeal (Case Number: 1D09-4779). Such information must be treated as confidential pending resolution of FPL's appeal, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(10), Fla. Admin. Code.

FPL has highlighted and redacted employee names and titles within these documents, in an effort to keep compensation information located on the same page confidential. FPL maintains that when employee names and/or titles are coupled with specific compensation information, the information constitutes competitively sensitive and private information. FPL has highlighted and redacted the names and titles – as opposed to the compensation dollar figures located on these pages – in an effort to allow public disclosure of the dollar figures themselves. The following Working Papers contain competitively sensitive and private employee compensation information.

Issue 2: Employee Information in Contracts

FPL is only requesting confidential classification of employee names and titles when that information is linked to compensation information, as described in Issue 1. FPL is separately requesting that certain information related to bids and contractual data be granted confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S. FPL treats documents containing contractual terms the disclosure of which would impair FPL's efforts to contract for goods or services on favorable terms as confidential documents. Accordingly, FPL has requested confidential treatment for these contracts and purchase orders. FPL agrees that certain employee personnel information within contract documents does not require confidential treatment. Therefore, FPL has revised the following Working Papers to remove from its request the lines or portions of lines where employee information, such as names, appear:



Issue 3: Names of FPL employees

In your February 4 letter, you question whether certain information related to employee names found within detailed staff audit working papers can receive confidential treatment. FPL has reviewed the Working Papers, and agrees that some of that information does not require confidential treatment. The revised Working Papers include:

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
