RE: Docket No. 971622-SU – In re: Initiation of show cause proceedings against Landmark Enterprises, Inc. in Highlands County for violation of Rule 25-30.110(3), F.A.C., Records and Reports; Annual Reports, and Rule 25-30.120, Regulatory Assessment Fees;

Docket No. 080236-SU – In re: Notice of abandonment of wastewater system in Highlands County by Landmark Utilities, Inc.; and

Docket No. 090471-SU – In re: Application for transfer of wastewater facilities to City of Sebring by Landmark Utilities, Inc.

Order No. PSC-10-0197-FOF-SU, issued March 30, 2010, in the above-referenced dockets acknowledged the abandonment of Landmark Utilities, Inc. and the transfer of the utility to the City of Sebring. The order further stated that “upon referral of the unpaid regulatory assessment fees, penalties, and interest to the Department of Financial Services regarding authority to write off the account as uncollectible, these dockets shall be closed administratively.”

By memo dated June 11, 2010, the unpaid regulatory assessment fees, penalties, and interest were referred to the Department of Financial Services for authority to write off the account as uncollectible. Therefore, these three dockets should be closed.
