TO ALL CREDITORS AND PARTIES IN INTEREST:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on April 26, 2010, at 2:30 p.m., in Courtroom 5D of the Ronald Reagan Federal Building and United States Courthouse located at 411 W. Fourth Street, Santa Ana. California, the Court is scheduled to hold a hearing on the motion (the "Motion") of the Official Post-Confirmation Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") of Incomnet Communications Corporation (the "Debtor"), for an order 12 (1) authorizing the distribution to creditors holding allowed general unsecured claims against the Debtor, (2) closing the case, (3) amending the scope of employment of Weiland, Golden, Smiley, Wang Ekvall & Strok, LLP (the "Firm"), counsel to the Committee, to include the filing of the Motion, (4) allowing fees and costs to the Firm on a final basis, and (5) allowing fees and costs of the Committee's accountant, Grobstein, Horwath & Company, LLP, on a final basis. A summary of the relief sought is as follows:

BACKGROUND FACTS

The Debtor's Plan and the Appointment of the Committee

On September 2, 1999, the Debtor and its parent company, Incomnet, Inc. ("IC"), (collectively, the Debtor and IC are referred to as the "Reorganized Debtors"), filed voluntary petitions under chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code. On May 9, 2000, the Court confirmed the Debtors' Third Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization (Dated March 14, 2000) (the "Plan"). Under the Plan, the Debtor's general unsecured creditors were classified in class 7 and are to receive distributions from a fund established for their benefit (referred to in the Plan as the "Class 7 Fund") that was comprised of a \$330,000 cash contribution from the Debtor and any net proceeds of avoidance actions that the Committee was vested with standing to pursue on behalf of Class 7. Under the Plan, the Committee was vested with standing to prosecute claim objections to Class 7 claims and to pursue avoidance actions belonging to the Debtor's bankruptcy estate for the benefit of Class 7.

The Committee subsequently retained the Firm as its counsel to (1) investigate, research, and evaluate the merits of avoidance claims; and (2) investigate and evaluate the merits of claims and to object to any claims. As compensation for work related to avoidance actions, the Firm agreed to receive a contingency fee equal to (1) 25% of the total gross settlement amount for each avoidance claim settled before the filing of an avoidance action or before the thirtieth calendar date before the matter is first set for trial and (2) 30% of the total gross settlement amount or total gross judgment amount for any avoidance action resolved on or after the thirtieth calendar day prior to the date that the matter was first set for trial. For services related to claims, the Firm was to be

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1 compensated on an hourly basis. The Firm was also entitled to be reimbursed for its actual, necessary expenses. In addition, the Firm sought and the Court approved 2 modified fee application procedures pursuant to which the Firm was permitted to file and serve a monthly professional fee statement and, if there was no objection, the Firm was authorized to be paid from the Class 7 Fund. The Firm filed seven professional fee statements.

The Class 7 Fund was not intended to be distributed until the Committee completed its claim objections and avoidance actions. Until then, the Plan required the Debtor to hold the Class 7 Fund. Once the Committee completed its tasks, it was required to notify 6 the Debtor who would then make disbursements on account of the allowed Class 7 claims. If the disbursing agent was someone other than the Reorganized Debtors, then Section III.A. of the Plan authorized the disbursing agent to employ with or contract with entities to make or assist with the distributions for "reasonable compensation" and reimbursement of expenses without the necessity of further Court approval.

The Debtor's Sale of Its Assets Required the Committee to Take Over the Debtor's Duties

In 2001, the Reorganized Debtors sold substantially all of their assets and began the process of dissolving under state law. Because of that, the Debtor could no longer serve as the disbursing agent for the Class 7 Fund. Accordingly, the Debtor and the Committee entered into a stipulation pursuant to which the Committee was appointed as the disbursing agent for the Class 7 Fund. The Court approved that stipulation by order entered on January 29, 2002. Since then, the Class 7 Fund has been held in the Firm's client trust account. In October 2002 and because the chair of the Committee resigned and the Committee was not equipped to make disbursements, the Committee retained Henry Arjad of CPT Group to serve as chairperson and to make the distributions to Class 7 in exchange for 1.5% of the funds that he distributes, plus reimbursement of costs.

Subsequently, in August 2003, the Committee entered into a second stipulation with the Debtor pursuant to which the Committee agreed to take over the responsibility of preparing post-confirmation status reports and filing disbursements reports with the Office of the United States Trustee. Accordingly, the Committee is the proper party to seek the relief in this Motion.

The Class 7 Fund

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As set forth above, the Class 7 Fund was comprised of \$330,000 in cash, plus avoidance action recoveries, less attorney's fees and costs.

Recoveries from Avoidance Actions

After the Plan was confirmed, the Committee filed a number of avoidance actions 23 on behalf of the Debtor's estate, the proceeds of which belonged to the Class 7 Fund. In addition, because there were a few entities that received avoidable transfers from both IC and the Debtor, rather than have two separate adversaries filed against the transferees, the Reorganized Debtors determined that it would be more prudent to vest the Committee 25 with standing to file one action and to enter into a sharing agreement regarding any recoveries. The Reorganized Debtors and the Committee reached an agreement pursuant to which the Committee agreed to pursue three avoidance actions on behalf of the Reorganized Debtors, with the net recovery after payment of attorney's fees and costs to be divided as set forth in the stipulation. Subsequently, the stipulation was amended to add an additional defendant.

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The Committee subsequently filed fourteen avoidance actions, eventually settling all of them and obtaining Court approval of the settlements. The last avoidance action was resolved in 2009. The following chart identifies the matters that resulted in recoveries and lists the amount of the recovery and the fees related thereto:

From the \$480,451,04, the Committee paid Incomnet, Inc., the sum of \$102,187.50 pursuant to the stipulations with IC for its share of the four avoidance actions jointly pursued. That amount was net of fees and costs incurred in connection with the avoidance actions. The Firm incurred total litigation costs of \$42,125.03 pursuing the avoidance actions Thus, the net recovery for the Class 7 Fund from avoidance actions is \$336,138.51.

The Committee's Retention and Payment of Accountants

In order to assist the Committee with issues germane to avoidance actions and to help the Committee determine which potential avoidance actions to actually pursue, the Committee retained Grobstein, Horwath & Company, LLP ("Grobstein"), as its accountants. Grobstein analyzed information obtained from the Debtor to determine which actions should be pursued. Once the avoidance actions were filed, Grobstein analyzed such issues as whether the Debtor was insolvent when the transfers were made or rendered insolvent as a result of them and whether the alleged preferential transfers

Under the settlement agreement with Mr. Jacobs that was approved by the Court, the matter was settled for \$5,000, \$2,000 of which was payable in cash. The balance was payable by contribution of the dividend that Mr. Jacobs would otherwise receive on account of his claim. Mr. Jacobs holds two allowed claims: claim 377 in the amount of \$40,000.00 and claim number 379 in the amount of \$549,776.92. As set forth infra, the estimated distribution on account of allowed claims is 6.12%, so that Mr. Jacobs would be entitled to a distribution in the amount of \$36,094.34 on account of these claims. That distribution will be reduced by \$3,000.00 to fund the balance of his settlement payment.

Claim Objections and a Settlement of an Administrative Claim

As contemplated by the Plan, the Committee was responsible for pursuing objections to Class 7 claims. The Firm filed nine omnibus claim objection motions and nearly all of the Firm's objections were sustained, with a few resolved by stipulation.

In addition, in 2003, U.S. Bancorp Equipment Finance filed a motion for allowance of a chapter 11 administrative expense claim against the Debtor, seeking payment of approximately \$67,000 from the Class 7 Fund. The Debtor and the Committee opposed the motion, but because there was a risk that U.S. Bancorp would prevail, reached a settlement prior to the hearing on the motion pursuant to which U.S. Bancorp was paid \$15,000.00 from the Class 7 Fund in settlement of its claims. The Court approved the motion by order entered on January 5, 2004.

All claim objections are complete. Attached hereto as Exhibit "1" is a list of the allowed Class 7 claims. As set forth on that chart, there is a total of \$7,760,550.95 in allowed Class 7 claims.

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In addition, in connection with this Motion and if the Court agrees that given the circumstances of this case in which the Committee was required to assume responsibility for tasks that the Debtor assumed under the Plan, it is appropriate to expand the scope of the Firm's employment to include preparation of this motion, then the Firm is seeking allowance of an additional \$21,736.00 in fees and \$27.27 costs, plus fees and costs incurred serving the Motion, responding to any inquiries, and attending the hearing on the Motion. The Firm believes that in connection with this request, it is important for parties to understand that as a result of the Debtor's cessation of business, the Firm was forced to accept additional responsibilities and, as a result, incurred fees substantially in excess of the additional fees and costs it is seeking through this Motion for which it is not requesting compensation.

Accounting of the Class 7 Fund

As of the filing of the Motion, the Class 7 Fund is comprised of \$505,996.65. An accounting is attached to the Motion as Exhibit "20."

D. Approval of the Proposed Disbursements Is Appropriate

As of the date of the filing of this motion, the Firm is holding the sum of \$505,996.65 in its client trust account. As set forth in footnote 1, this amount will increase by \$3,000.00 because of the contribution of \$3,000.00 of the dividend that Edward Jacobs would otherwise receive, as set forth in the settlement agreement that resolved the preference action filed against him. Thus, the Class 7 Fund will increase to \$508,996.65 once this dividend is contributed. Pursuant to his agreement with the Committee, Mr. Arjad is entitled to 1.5% of that amount, or approximately \$7,634.50, as compensation for serving as the disbursing agent. He is also entitled to reimbursement of costs incurred in making the disbursements, which must be estimated in order to facilitate the disbursement. Given that there are approximately 215 claimants in class 7 who will receive a distribution, the total cost for postage and envelopes is estimated to be approximately \$500.00. In addition to the cost of envelopes and postage, because of the passage of time since the claims were filed, the addresses will need to be run through a database containing changes of address in order to help ensure that the checks are mailed to the correct address. The fee for this service is approximately \$100.00. Thus, these costs and the payment of the supplemental fees and costs sought by the Firm, if allowed, will reduce the amount available for distribution to approximately \$475,000,00.

As set forth in the chart of Class 7 claims attached hereto as Exhibit "1," the total of the allowed Class 7 claims is \$7,760,550.95. Thus, creditors in Class 7 will receive a pro rata distribution of approximately 6.12% of their allowed claims.

E. The Plan Has Been Substantially Consummated and Entry of the Final Decree Is Appropriate

Here, the estate has been fully administered. The order confirming the Plan is final, all contested matters and adversary proceedings have been fully and finally resolved, and the only item remaining is distribution of the Class 7 Fund, which will be accomplished once the Court authorizes the proposed distributions. In light of the foregoing, entry of a final decree closing the case is appropriate at this time.
