FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF ENERGY CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY TRUE-UP FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2010

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-11-0136-PCO-EG, issued on February 28, 2011 in the above-referenced Docket, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") petitions the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for approval of an overrecovery of \$9,183,523 as FPL's net true-up amount for the January 2010 through December 2010 Energy Conservation Cost Recovery ("ECCR") final true-up period. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

- 1. FPL is a public utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Chapter 366, Florida Statutes. Pursuant to Section 366.82, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-17.015, Florida Administrative Code, FPL has an ECCR clause through which it recovers its reasonable and prudent unreimbursed costs for conservation audits, conservation programs, and implementation of FPL's conservation plan. FPL has substantial interests in the proper calculation and recovery of its ECCR factor and the final true-up which is used in the computation of FPL's ECCR factor.
- 2. FPL seeks Commission approval of an overrecovery of \$9,183,523 as the net true-up amount for the period January 2010 through December 2010. FPL's final net true-up for January 2010 through December 2010 was calculated consistently with the methodology set forth in Schedule 1, page 2 of 2, attached to Order No. 10093, dated June 19, 1981. This

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calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in Exhibit AS-1, an exhibit cosponsored by witnesses Anita Sharma and Terry J. Keith whose testimonies are being filed
contemporaneously with this Petition. Exhibit AS-1 consists of (a) the Energy Conservation
Cost Recovery True-Up Reporting Forms that FPL and other utilities were directed to file by the
Commission's Electric & Gas Department memorandum dated April 14, 1982, (b) explanatory
supplements to certain of the forms, (c) a complete list of account and subaccount numbers used
for ECCR as required by Rule 25-17.015(3), Florida Administrative Code, and (d)
documentation necessary to support claimed energy savings in conservation advertising as
required by Rule 25-17.015(5), Florida Administrative Code.

- 3. Rule 25-17.015, Florida Administrative Code, provides, in pertinent part, that each utility seeking conservation cost recovery must file "an annual final true-up filing showing the common costs, individual program costs and revenues, and actual total ECCR revenues for the most recent 12-month historical period from January 1 through December 31 that ends prior to the annual ECCR proceedings." For the proceedings scheduled for November 2011, that twelve-month period is January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010; therefore, FPL's true-up filing is for the twelve months period from January 2010 through December 2010.
- 4. FPL's current ECCR Factor, approved by the Commission to be applied to customers' bills during the January 2011 through December 2011 period, reflected an actual/estimated true-up underrecovery of \$47,774,401 for the January 2010 through December 2010 period. However, the actual end of period true-up underrecovery for the January 2010 through December 2010 period was \$38,590,879. The net true-up of \$9,183,523 for the period January 2010 through December 2010 is the difference between the actual end of period true-up underrecovery for the January 2010 through December 2010 period of \$38,590,879 and FPL's

approved actual/estimated true-up underrecovery of \$47,774,401. This \$9,183,523 is the amount that should be recovered on jurisdictional sales during FPL's next annual ECCR recovery period.

- 5. FPL is not aware of any disputed issues of material fact.
- 6. This is a petition requesting approval of a true-up amount for ECCR; it is not a petition in response to an agency action. Therefore, FPL cannot provide "a statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the agency decision."
- 7. The approval of FPL's final ECCR net true-up overrecovery of \$9,183,523 for the period January 2010 through December 2010 is in the public interest. Section 366.82, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-17.015, Florida Administrative Code, entitle FPL to relief.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests that the Commission approve an overrecovery of \$9,183,523 as the final net true-up amount for the January 2010 through December 2010 period, and that the approved final net true-up amount be carried over and reflected in FPL's 2012 ECCR factors.
