On August 31, 2011, pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(3), Florida Administrative Code, Progress Energy Florida, Inc., (PEF) requested confidential classification of certain information contained in Hearing Exhibits 207, 210 and 212 submitted in Docket No. 110009-EI.

Staff has reviewed FPL's confidentiality request. In staff's opinion, the request does meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093, Florida Statutes. Therefore, staff recommends approval of FPL's request of confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 06282-11.
