Dear Water System Owner:

Following a field inspection conducted on April 6, 2011 we have determined that you water system should be regulated by the Polk County Health Department as a Consecutive Community water system in accordance to the Safe Drinking Water Act and Chapter 62-550 and 62-555 of the Florida Administrative Code. You will be required to comply with the following items:

1. You must submit a bacteriological sampling plan to this office for approval. This plan must be written in accordance with Chapter 62-550.518 of the Florida Administrative code.
2. You must begin conducting monthly bacteriological monitoring in accordance with the bacteriological sampling plan approved by the Department and Chapter 62-550.518 FAC.
3. You must submit a lead and copper sampling plan for approval in accordance with Chapter 62-550.800 FAC and 40CFR Part 141 of the Federal Register.
4. You must monitor for lead and copper during two consecutive six month periods according to your approved lead and copper sampling plan.
5. You must monitor for asbestos in accordance with Chapter 62-550.511 FAC or, if asbestos pipe is not present in the distribution system a waiver from asbestos testing may be obtained by certifying in writing, using form 62-555.900(10) FAC, that the system is without asbestos-containing components and is essentially asbestos free. Form 62-555.900(10) may be located at <http://www.dep.state.fl.us/water/drinkingwater/forms.htm>.
6. You must prepare and submit on a monthly basis Monthly Operation Reports for Consecutive Public Water Systems that do not treat their water, DEP Form 62.555.900(4) which may be located at <http://www.dep.state.fl.us/water/drinkingwater/forms.htm>.

7. You must prepare and Submit a Consumer Confidence Report each year in accordance with Chapter 62-550.824 FAC and 40CFR Part 141, Subpart O, section 151-155 and Appendix A. Your first Consumer Confidence Report will be due in 2009.
8. You must maintain a minimum free chlorine residual of 0.2 mg/l or a combined chlorine residual of 0.6 mg/l throughout the water distribution system at all times as required in Chapter 62-555-.350(6). The chlorine residual must be measured a minimum of twice a week and recorded on a monthly operation report.
9. All security related incidents must be reported to the State Warning Point at 1-800-320-0519 with your PWS # 6535727 in accordance with Chapter 62-555.350(2) FAC.
10. All dead end water mains must be flushed quarterly or in accordance with a written flushing plan as per Chapter 62-555.350(2).
11. You must begin maintaining system records as required by Chapter 62-555.720. Please use the following table as reference.

Record	Retention period
Bacteriological Analysis pursuant to Chapter 62-550	Not less than 5 years
Chemical Analysis pursuant to Chapter 62-550	Not less than 10 years
Records of action taken by the system to correct a violation of primary drinking water standards	Not less than 3 years after the last action taken with respect to the particular violation involved
Written reports, summaries, or communications relating to cross connection control programs or sanitary surveys of the system conducted by any local, state, or federal agency	Not less than 10 years after completion of the sanitary survey
Records concerning a variance or exemption granted to the system	Not less than 5 years following the expiration of the variance or exemption
Water plant operation reports	Not less than 5 years
Any system subject to the requirements of the Lead and Copper Rule shall retain original records of all sampling data and analysis, reports, surveys, letters, evaluations, schedules, Department determinations, and any other information required by this rule.	Not less than 12 years

12. Chapter 62-555.350(14) requires the supplier of water to have an updated map of the drinking water system. The map must show the location and size of water mains if known, location of valves and fire hydrants, pumping facilities and any interconnections with other public water systems.
13. Chapter 62-555.360(2) requires all community water systems to establish and **implement** a routine cross-connection control program to detect and control cross-connections and prevent backflow of contaminants into the water system. This program shall include a written plan that is developed using recommended practices of American Water Works Association set forth in *Recommended Practice for Backflow Prevention and Cross-Connection Control, AWWA Manual M14*, as incorporated into Rule 62-555.330 FAC.

14. The water system must also comply with all applicable rules regarding Public Water Systems. These rules may be found at <http://www.dep.state.fl.us/water/rulesprog.htm#dw>.

Please take the necessary steps to correct these deficiencies within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice, unless otherwise specified and **notify the Department in writing**. If the deficiencies cannot be corrected within the thirty (30) day period, a written schedule stating when the deficiencies will be corrected must be submitted to this office within the thirty (30) day time frame. Failure to comply will result in referral to the enforcement section for further action and the possible imposition of a fine.

Dear Public Water System Owner:

This letter is to advise you of the violations of law for which the above mentioned facility's public water system may be responsible and to seek your cooperation in resolving the matter. A review of the facility's drinking water records indicates that violations of Florida Statutes and Rules may exist at the facility. FDOH letters dated April 11, 2011 & July 17, 2011 cited that you may have potential violations for failing to meet the operational and monitoring requirements of a consecutive community water system as required by Chapters 62-550 and 62-655 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C). The following are violation which currently exist with your system:

- System failed to monitor for bacteriological contaminants as required by Chapter 62-550.518(2) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- System failed to provide a written bacteriological sampling plan in accordance with Chapter 62-550.518 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). This plan shall addresses location, timing, frequency, and rotation period for bacteriological sampling.
- System failed to monitor for lead and copper during two consecutive six month periods in accordance with Chapter 62-550.800 FAC and 40CFR Part 141 of the Federal Register.
- System failed to provide a lead and copper sampling plan for approval in accordance with Chapter 62-550.800 FAC and 40CFR Part 141 of the Federal Register.

- System failed to monitor for asbestos in accordance with Chapter 62-550.511 FAC or, if asbestos pipe is not present in the distribution system a waiver from asbestos testing may be obtained by certifying in writing, using form 62-555.900(10) FAC, that the system is without asbestos-containing components and is essentially asbestos free.
- System failed to provide public notice that your system failed to monitor in accordance with Chapter 62-550 and Chapter 62-560 of the Florida Administrative Code.
- The Department has not received required Monthly Operation Reports. Chapter 62-555.350(12)(b) requires public water systems to complete and submit Monthly Operation Reports to the Department within ten (10) days after the end of each month.
- System failed to prepare and provide a consumer confidence report to customers and the Department in accordance with Chapter 62-550.824(3) (e) 1.b of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)
- The Department has not received Form 62-555.900(19), Certification of Delivery of Consumer Confidence Report, to the Department in accordance with Chapter 62-550.824(3) (e) 1.b of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)
- The system is not maintaining its records as required by Chapter 62-550.720 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- The system does not have an adequate cross connection control plan. Chapter 62-555.360(2) requires all community water systems to establish and implement a routine cross connection control program to detect and control cross-connections that create or may create an imminent and substantial danger to public health. This program shall include a written plan that is developed using recommended practices of American Water Works Association set forth in *Recommended Practice for Backflow Prevention and Cross-Connection Control, AWWA Manual M14*, as incorporated into Rule 62-555.330, F.A.C.
- System failed to measure/record the residual disinfectant concentration in the distribution system in accordance with Chapter 62-555.350(6)(b) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- System failed to provide a written flushing program in accordance with 62-555.350(2) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- System failed to flush dead-end mains quarterly or in accordance with a written flushing program established by the supplier of water in accordance with 62-555.350(2) of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)
