AQUA UTILITIES FLORIDA, INC.'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ABATEMENT OF PROCEEDING

Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. ("AUF" or "Company"), by and through its undersigned counsel, respectfully moves the Commission to issue an order abating this proceeding for a period of six months, and as grounds therefor states:

1. On January 7, 2011, AUF filed an Application for Original Certificate for an Existing Wastewater System, Request for Initial Rates and Charges, and Amendment of Certificate in Lake County, Florida, and an Application for Approval of Transfer of Harbor Hills Utilities, L.P. Water System and Amendment of Certificate in Lake County, Florida, (the "Applications").

2. Since the Applications were filed, Mr. Robert Nicholson and Mr. Peder Hong have filed petitions for formal hearing in opposition to the Applications.
