
Cordia Communications Corp. ("Cordia") filed for protection under Chapter 11 of the US Bankruptcy Code, Case 6:11-bk-06493 on May 1, 2011 in the Middle District of Florida. Attached for your reference is a copy of the filing receipt. Cordia entered into an asset purchase agreement with Birch Telecom of the South, Inc. dba Birch Telecom dba Birch Communications and transferred its customer base to Birch on or about October 14, 2011. Cordia and Birch filed the required waiver request for the aforementioned transaction the Public Service Commission on July 19, 2011.

Cordia does not currently serve any end-users in the State of Florida and wishes to surrender the licenses granted to it to provide telecommunications services in the State effective December 31, 2011. Please note that, although the Commission no longer regulates interexchange service, Cordia's request for surrender includes both its CLEC and IXC authority.

Cordia is still in bankruptcy, no longer provides services to any end users in any jurisdiction and therefore does not earn revenues, and is currently winding down operations. As a result, Cordia is unable to pay any Regulatory Assessment Fees due to the Commission and is requesting a bankruptcy cancellation of its licenses and waiver of filing and assessment fees.
