On June 6, 2012, Halo Wireless, Inc. (Halo) filed a Request for Confidential Classification of DN 03700-12 (x-ref. DN 03157-12). The company believes that the documents contain proprietary confidential business information and has provided detailed reasons why this information should be treated as confidential in its filing.

After reviewing the above referenced documents, staff agrees that disclosure of the redacted information could be detrimental to Halo; therefore, staff recommends the request be granted.
