PREHEARING STATEMENT**

Pursuant to the requirements of the Order on Procedure, Order No. PSC-12-0079-PCO-GU, Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC") hereby submits its Prehearing Statement.

A. Known Witnesses

Florida Public Utilities intends to offer the direct testimony of Michelle Napier dated April 27, 2012, and dated September 5, 2012.

C. Basic Position

FPUC has appropriately calculated its true-up amounts and purchased gas adjustment factor as shown in the Company's positions on Issues 1-5.

D. – F. Issues

FPUC's positions on the issues identified by Staff are as follows:

Issue 1: What are the final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2011 through December 2011?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$258,415.

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Issue 2: What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2012 through December 2012?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$1,007,799.

Issue 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected during the period January 2013 through December 2013?

FPUC: An over-recovery of \$1,266,214.

Issue 4: What are the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

FPUC: The appropriate PGA factor is 93.410 cents per therm, which includes Peninsula Pipeline capacity costs included in the Company's 2013 projections and anticipated additional upstream supply and capacity to serve new customers in 2013 in Nassau County.

Issue 5: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

FPUC: The factors should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2013 and should apply for bills rendered for meter readings taken between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2013.


