Docket No. 100432-TP - Request for emergency relief and complaint of American Dial Tone, Inc. against BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida to resolve interconnection agreement dispute.

Dear Mssrs. Biddix and Follensbee:

I am writing to inquire about the status of the above two dockets. A review of the docket files indicates there has been no activity in the American Dial Tone proceeding since a February 23, 2011 letter, which indicated the parties required additional time to discuss how to proceed with the docket. There has been no activity in the LifeConnex proceeding since an October 31, 2011 Status Report, indicating that the parties did not anticipate any action in Florida until related proceedings were resolved in other states.

Given the lack of activity in the dockets and the length of time they have been open, staff believes that the dockets should either be closed or should be returned to active proceedings so that the Commission can resolve the proceedings. I am therefore writing to inquire as to the parties' positions on closure of both dockets. If the parties believe that one or both dockets should not be closed, then I request a detailed explanation of the reasons such docket(s) should remain open and a proposed schedule for the resumption of proceedings, including suggestions for hearing timeframes and requested hearing dates. If I do not receive any information from the parties by November 16, 2012,
