Issue 1: What is the appropriate disposition of Mr. Smallakoff's complaint?

Recommendation: Mr. Smallakoff's complaint should be denied and he should pay the outstanding amount of \$320 \$340 as previously billed by the utility. It appears that Mr. Smallakoff's account was properly billed in accordance with Commission statutes, rules, and PEF's tariffs. Staff requests approval to make an oral modification to Issue 1 of the recommendation for the above-referenced item. This issue relates to a consumer complaint filed by Mr. Smallakoff. The modification is necessary in order to correct two identical typographic errors in which the disputed amount of funds billed to Mr. Smallakoff was incorrectly written as \$340 instead of the correct amount of \$320. The \$320 amount is derived from a \$280 additional security deposit imposed by PEF as a condition of reconnecting his power and a \$40 reconnection fee. The correct \$320 amount is used throughout the rest of the recommendation.

1) Page 5, Issue 1, Recommendation Paragraph

Issue 1: What is the appropriate disposition of Mr. Smallakoff's complaint?

Recommendation: Mr. Smallakoff's complaint should be denied and he should pay the outstanding amount of <u>\$320</u> \$340. (Lawson)
