The purpose of this letter is to ask for an increase in customer monthly billing expense.

In the short time I have owned Pinecrest Utilities, LLC there have been occasions where customers have called the office and told us they have not received the monthly invoices.

Currently, I send the monthly customer invoices via pre stamped post card from the Untied States Postal Service. The current cost of this postcard not including labor or printing costs is \$.37

I am asking for an increase to mail the monthly customer invoice in an envelope as part of this SARC. I have prepared the following:

Current pre stamped USPS postcard mailing costs \$.37 per piece X 145 customers= \$ 54 per month x 12 months per year = \$648

Envelope Mailing costs. \$.46 (Stamp) + .03 (envelope) = $\$.49 \times 145$ Customers = \$71.00 per month X 12 months per year = \$852.

\$852-\$648 = \$204 yearly increased cost to mail envelopes.

I request a yearly cost increase of \$204 to mail monthly customer invoices in an envelope.
