#### CHARGES REVISIONS EFFECTIVE June 1, 2013

Talquin Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Talquin" or the "Cooperative") has been actively installing AMI meters equipped with radio transmitters and disconnect/reconnect modules since 2010 with bulk of the residential meters being installed at year end 2011. This has allowed the Cooperative to do away with the inefficient and error prone self-read system while realizing the benefits and conveniences of a traditional AMI metering system.

Talquin received several requests for AMI Meter Opt-Out from the Members who expressed their desire to retain original electromechanical meters for one reason or another. Considering that such opt-out program would necessitate manual meter reading function, Talquin has calculated the costs associated with that workload. That information was related to the Members wishing to opt-out and most have agreed to bear that cost with understanding that Members can request an AMI meter at any time in the future should their circumstances change for any reason. Such custom reading, given Talquin's average density of just 12 Members per mile, would cost the Cooperative an amount in excess of the requested \$40 charge. However, it was our management's decision to err on the side of caution and to request an approval of a lesser charge while monitoring our actual costs in the future.

It is our intent to recover the actual costs of such service without causing an undue burden to the rest of the Talquin Members. It is also our intent to be responsive to our Members' needs and requests while passing along the associated costs to the affected groups. Talquin Electric
