Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC") hereby submits this preliminary statement of

issues and positions:

- **<u>ISSUE 1</u>**: What are the final conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2012 through December 2012?
- <u>FPUC:</u> An under-recover of \$123,947.
- **<u>ISSUE 2</u>**: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2014 through December 2014?
- FPUC: FPUC seeks to recover \$657,334.
- **ISSUE 3**: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2014 through December 2014?
- <u>FPUC:</u> The Company asks for approval of a consolidated levelized conservation cost recovery factor for this period of \$.00100 per KWH.
- **<u>ISSUE 4</u>**: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?
- FPUC: The factor should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2014 through December 2014. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2014 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2014, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.
