



By Order No. PSC-17-0091-FOF-SU issued March 13, 2017, the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) approved an increase in wastewater rates, a late payment charge, an increase in miscellaneous service charges, non-sufficient funds (NSF) charges, and a lift station cleaning charge for K W Resort Utilities Corp. (utility). In addition, the Commission approved a continuation of the utility's existing plant capacity charge. A schedule of Commission approved rates and charges are set forth below.

The final rates granted by the Commission were lower than those granted in the proposed agency action proceeding and, as such, the utility will be providing refunds with interest, to all customers so entitled.

The rates shall be effective for service rendered as of the Commission's stamped approval date on the tariff sheets provided the customers have received notice. If the effective date of the new rates falls within a regular billing cycle, the initial bills at the new rate may be prorated. The old charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle before the effective date of the new rates. The new charges shall be prorated based on the number of days in the billing cycle on or after the effective date of the new rates.
