- 22.** On page 2 of the petition, the company indicated that it “is seeking approval to recover the unamortized costs for MH and HPS luminaires” which are of \$37,780,595, as of August 31, 2017. Please clarify whether these are the assets for which the company is requesting a capital recovery schedule in Docket No. 20170198-EI. If not, please explain.
- A.** Yes, the 209,821 luminaires that are in this petition are the existing MH and HPS that are in the field at this time. This Docket No. 20170199-EI asks for the recovery of the unamortized depreciation amount for these existing MH and HPS luminaires. In the 20170199-EI petition the amount requested to be recovered per fixture is \$180.06 based upon each fixture replaced with a qualifying LED luminaire. These MH and HPS luminaires are the luminaires to which the capital recovery schedule in Docket No. 20170198-EI is being requested to recover.
