**Docket No. 20170271-EI** – Petition for recovery of costs associated with named tropical systems during the 2015, 2016, and 2017 hurricane seasons and replenishment of storm reserve subject to final true-up, Tampa Electric Company.

<u>Issue 1:</u> Should the Commission authorize Tampa Electric to implement interim Storm Cost Recovery Charge factors?

<u>Recommendation:</u> Yes, the Commission should authorize Tampa Electric to implement interim Storm Cost Recovery Charge factors, subject to refund. Once the total actual storm costs are known, Tampa Electric should be required to file documentation of the storm costs for Commission review and true-up of any excess or shortfall.

The appropriate security to guarantee the funds collected subject to refund is a corporate undertaking.

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<u>Issue 2:</u> Should the Commission approve Tampa Electric's proposed tariffs and associated charges? <u>Recommendation:</u> Yes. The Commission should approve Tampa Electric's tariffs as proposed in the amended petition to go into effect with the first billing cycle in April 2018.

The Commission noted to approve the amended implementation stipulation, and tECO withdrew its tamiff associated with the Atom Surchange petition. These actions make Issue 2 moot.
