Thank you for contacting the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) about the sale of Vero Beach Electric Utility to Florida Power & Light Company (FPL). Your comments are included in the docket correspondence for Commissioners and staff to review. You can find additional case information on the PSC's website, [www.FloridaPSC.com](http://www.FloridaPSC.com): click on the *Clerk's Office* tab, then click *Dockets*, and enter the docket number: #20170235, or #20170236 (either will work).

On July 2, 2018, the PSC voted to issue a Proposed Agency Action approving FPL's requested accounting treatment for recording the Vero Beach Electric Utility purchase. To be clear, the PSC has no jurisdiction to approve or disapprove the sale itself, and can only consider the accounting treatment and related issues before the Commission.

Since there were four protests to the PSC's Proposed Agency Action, the Commission was required by law to set this matter for hearing. The evidentiary hearing was held on October 9 in Tallahassee, where Commissioners heard from attending parties and members of the public. A decision is expected on November 27.
