Sir,

AARP Florida has advised regarding Florida electric utilities' Storm Protection Plans.

AARP Florida estimates Florida electric customers will pay \$40 billion for implementation of the plans by 2059.

All customers will subsidize a tiny few. Despite the SPPs massive size, few customers will experience shorter storm-related outages.

The SPPs are not strategic, and do not consider any modern options for reducing grid dependence, such as: solar, batteries, or a more decentralized electricity system.

None of the SPPs complied with the PSC's own Rules (25-6-030) for such plans.

The plans anticipate rate increases of \$18 to \$29 per customer, per month by 2029.

Considering the above, I am firmly opposed to the Plans.
